ADAPTATION OF FOREIGN EXPERIENCE IN TRANSFORMING THE SUGAR INDUSTRY OF UKRAINE IN THE CONTEXT OF ECONOMIC SECURITY

The article deals with the approaches to organization of operation of the sugar industry in Ukraine taking into account the best foreign experience of transformation industry to ensure appropriate level of economic security. The article represents analysis of foreign concepts of security of sugar industry in the European Union (EU) and economic security, which may be used to improve the methods of economic security of functioning of sugar industry in Ukraine. The author investigated practice of state regulation by formation and realization of trends in economic security of sugar industry in foreign countries: the European Union (EU) experience in this process.

The article is devoted to the problem of adaptation of foreign experience in the field of the system of economic security. Author carried out the analysis of international experience of counteracting the threats to economic security in

relation to forming directions of practical application in the sphere of economic security of sugar industry in Ukraine. Threats to sugar industry in Ukraine have been analyzed and identified. In article the author summarizes trends in dealing with threats similar to the European experience.

The author determines priority directions of borrowing of foreign experience. Thus, it is proved that the improvement of efficiency and modernization of both activity of enterprises and functioning of public authorities must become the consequences of not only adaptation, but also of obligatory improvement of high quality indexes of economic security.

On the basis of the presented comparative aspects of financial result of sugar industry in national and foreign practice, the author provides suggestions regarding the improvement of economic security of sugar industry in Ukraine.
