STATE ENVIRONMENTAL POLICY FOR THE UNITED LOCAL COMMUNITIES IN THE SYSTEM OF THE POWER DECENTRALIZATION

Considered are specific features of formation, implementation and socio-economic ensuring of the state environmental policy at the level of the united local communities under decentralization extension in Ukraine. Determined are conditions and features of the legislative support of the united communities formation. The necessity is proved of the local authorities decentralization basing on the principles of sustainable development only, i.e. on the balanced economic, environmental and social issues of the local level. Specified are the ways and methods to facilitate potential of the local communities financial resilience via re-destribution of the available and expected incomes of the local level, the techniques of financial support increase (of the united local communities) being determined. Emphasized is formation of the managing and economic mechanisms of the local self-government environmental policy. Implementation of the local environmental policy while forming united local communities is elucidated, the ways of its solution being suggested.

To decentralization reform helped strengthen the organizational, material, financial and legal independence combined local communities, we need a separation of powers between local governments at various levels and ensure improvement of the budgetary system to ensure that communities have filled their budgets, about the possibility of 'yednuvaty efforts and accumulate finances to create structures capable. Research in this area is important for the further development of decentralization reforms.
